#### i-Smith System (Private File Protection):



- c. Convenient install / uninstall process.
- d. Password protection.
- e. Multiple virtual disks set up.

#### 1. Installation

1-1 Connect your GM5 WiFi USB Adapter Card to your computer and insert the install disk into your CD/DVD drive.






1-2-1: Enter your Name, Company Name, and Install path

1-2-2: Windows will reboot after the installation is complete.

1-2-3: After rebooting, you will see the Virtual Disk (i-Smith) in the bottom right-hand corner of the screen.



1-3-1 Enter the ID Number (C28C85C5094CFA03)

1-3-2 Enter Virtual Disk Version user name (Up To You)



1-3-3 Enter Virtual Disk password (Up To You, no more 16)

1-3-4 Enter password to confirm again, and press OK to go on I-Smith

## Uninstall

1-1 Open Control Panel and select the Uninstall or change a program.

1-2 Select Virtual Disk and click on Uninstall/Change.



1-3 Enter the User Name and Password (you decided at the beginning) to uninstall Virtual Disk.




## 2. Application


A maximum of four virtual disks can be created using the **i-SmithSystem**. Those virtual disks are protected by a personal password and the GM5 network card. The virtual disks will disappear when a customer closes the **i-SmithSystem** and reboots the computer. There is no way to find the virtual disks you set up without the **GM5** card. Therefore, the **GM5** card is the key to open up your personal private folders and files. The **i-SmithSystem** strengthens the security of all private information.


“ADD” function

1-1 Double click the Virtual Disk icon to bring the I-Smith’s menu to the foreground.




1-2 Press  to add a new virtual disk.





- a. Drive letter: Select a Drive letter for the virtual disk.
- b. Size (MB): Amount of hard drive space allocated for the virtual disk.



- c. Storage drive: Storage location for the virtual disks.
- d. Free space: Amount of unused hard drive space available.
- e. Image name: The image name of virtual disk for saving backup copy.
- f. Restore: Revert all settings back to the backup copy you saved from e step.

**Note: You can only have a maximum of four virtual disks.**

1-3 Press  to delete the virtual disk.

1-4 Press  to modify the virtual disks were created.

1-5 Press  to edit your settings (i.e. new key series, interface etc.).

1-6 Press  to close the I-Smith System.

**Attention:**

1. **The i-Smith System will not load without the GM5 network card.**
2. **As the i-Smith System was opened, it is fine to pull out the GM5 network card.**

**Conclusion:**

The **i-Smith System** keeps your data protected quickly by easily hiding files/folders from anyone who uses your computer. The **GM5** and **i-Smith System** must be utilized together in order to protect your data. As a result, it certainly augments network privacy and safe guards against attacks by hackers.
